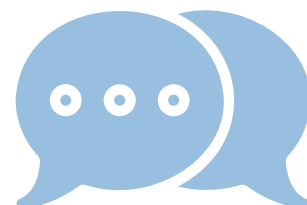

- Patient-reported outcomes and value-based care integration.

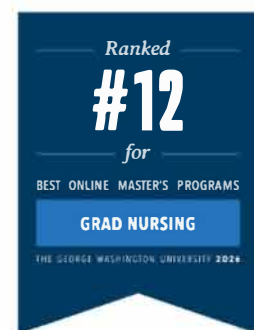


The Roundtable is designed for multi-stakeholder dialogue and educational exchange. Dues do not influence Coalition clinical guidance or grant product exclusivity.
